

AICIP RE-EXAMINATION POLICY

To gain certification, candidates must achieve a score of 70% or higher on each paper. If a candidate has scored a minimum of 50% on any paper they will be able to re-sit any failed exam(s). If a candidate has passed some of the exams, these paper(s) will be held for a maximum of 2 years from the original examination (first date). Failure on third attempt means no papers can be held and you will be required to re-sit all papers again.

Applicants re-sitting an examination must fill out the application form for the next set of examinations. This can be done by logging in the AICIP Website.

Applicants should contact AICIP in writing if they are unable to re-sit the failed examination paper(s) within the 2-year period. A decision on extending the set timeframe will go to the AICIP board for review.
