## 1. Preliminary Information

2.4 Using your mobile phone camera, scan the QR code at the bottom of the question and tap the link to be directed to the WeldQ upload page.







2.6 Take a photo of your answer (1 page at a time) and then click “Use Photo” for iOS or “OK” for Android devices.

2.7 If you need to submit additional images, click on the green  button (maximum of 6 uploads per question).

2.8 To remove an upload, click the  button, or to re-upload click the  button again.

2.9 To view your upload, click on the blue jpg link  

2.10 When completing that question click  and then close the window (**Important: if you don’t click save, your answers won’t be submitted when the exam finishes**).

2.11 For a successful upload, you will be directed to the “Upload Success” screen and may now close the window.

### 3. Answering in WeldQ

If the question doesn’t require you to upload an image or you would prefer typing the long-response answer directly into WeldQ, it is possible to drag the text box window to a larger size by clicking and dragging from the bottom right-hand corner. This can be repeated for each long-response question. You do not need to scan the QR code or submit anything for this instance.
